COVID-19 Update

Dear Patients and Families,

We are so thrilled to be opening our doors to the community at a time when daily life is gradually starting to return to normal, and we can finally meet and connect in person.

I wanted to share with you the protocols we've put in place to ensure a healthy environment for all of our patients and families.

We will continue to require masks for fully vaccinated and unvaccinated people over the age of 2. The mask wearing requirement for Colorado was recently amended in Executive Order D 2021 103 on May 14, 2021. The amended Executive Order states that fully vaccinated people can go without masks in public indoor spaces unless the setting requires otherwise. However, masks are still required for fully vaccinated and unvaccinated people over the age of 2 in certain settings and unvaccinated people over age 11 are encouraged to continue wearing masks in all public indoor spaces where members of different households are present.

At Northfield Pediatric Dentistry, we treat children who may be immunocompromised and we have a responsibility to keep them and their families safe. Research shows that people who have no symptoms can also spread COVID-19 and wearing a mask helps minimize the spread of the virus. If you or your child have any viral symptoms, we kindly ask that you call our office ahead of time to reschedule your appointment. We also ask that you respect our office policy to wear a mask and reserve the right to refuse care if you present to our office with symptoms or without a mask.

We have designed our office with a state-of-the art internally built air filtration purification system as well as Medi-Air HEPA filters in every treatment room, and our staff is trained in strict OSHA and PPE guidelines. We will continue to restrict the number of families in our waiting room and patient play areas to create a comfortable environment for our children and families.

We look forward to welcoming you to your child's new dental home, Northfield Pediatric Dentistry, and thank you for your trust in our care!
